

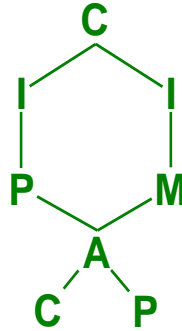

Documents should be available in time to everybody attending the meeting. May I therefore ask you to send me – again before 21st May – a list of documents you are going to distribute.

I am looking forward to receiving information on the reports on completed studies and thank you for the contribution to the work of CPAC.
