

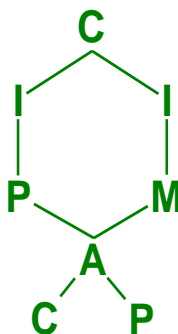

687 difenoconazole

Dear Colleague,

This is to inform you that Syngenta Crop Protection AG is planning to organise a full scale collaborative trial on a method for difenoconazole.

Principle: The content of difenoconazole in technical concentrate and the formulations is determined by gas chromatography on a DB-5 or equivalent fused silica column, 30 m length, 0.25 mm i.d., 0.25 µm film thickness, using hydrogen as carrier gas and flame ionization detection. Quantitation is done by internal standard calibration.

Scope: It is intended to analyse five samples consisting of two technical concentrates (TK), two emulsifiable concentrates (EC) and one water-dispersible granule (WG). Samples, analytical standard and internal standard will be provided.

Time schedule: The collaborative trial is intended to be carried out between February 2022- April 2022. Those who wish to participate should contact the organiser by January 15th 2022. The results should be reported by the end of April 2022.

Further information: The trial is limited to 20 participating laboratories due to the availability of samples. The selection criteria is "first come, first served".
